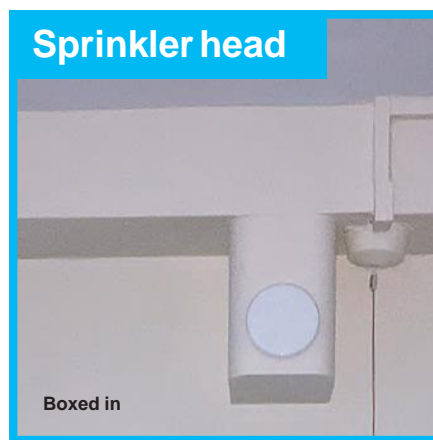
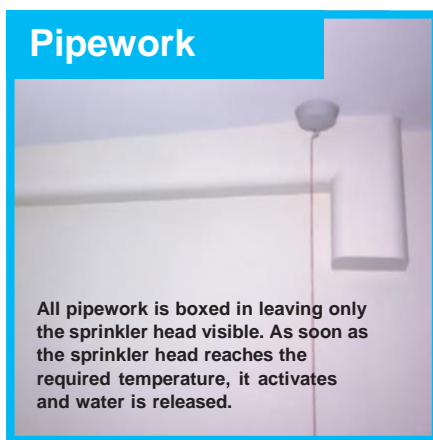


Sprinkler Fact Sheet

Installing sprinklers adds to the robust fire safety measures already in place. This is a typical example of an installed sprinkler.



IMPORTANT

- Please keep all sprinkler systems free from obstruction – ensure each sprinkler head isn't covered by pictures, stacked boxes or furniture. If the sprinkler head is covered it is unlikely to effectively put out a fire
- Do NOT attempt to hang anything from any part of the sprinkler system
- Do NOT attempt to hang/drill/screw anything to the trunking or sprinkler installation
- Do NOT tamper/remove the sprinkler head or trunking
- Do NOT paint/decorate the sprinkler head or trunking
- DO NOT use steam wallpaper strippers in rooms that have sprinklers installed
- If there is any damage to the sprinkler head please log a repair at the contact centre immediately on 0121 216 3330
- If there is a fire in your flat and the sprinkler has been activated follow your fire procedure and leave the premises. For further information please go to our website: birmingham.gov.uk/sprinklers
